Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to damage to belting etc., through heavy weather being permanently repaired at a convenient opportunity.

The Sydney Surveyors now report the vessel examined on a pontoon, bottom recoated and damage through heavy weather repaired as necessary.

The Owners now state that as the vessel is on Ferry service in Sydney Harbour and under constant supervision, they desire the class to be withdrawn.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
