Dear Sirs,

M I have to inform you that a first entry report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam on the new Hopper Barge No. 169 built by Messrs. Gebr. Jonkers, from which it appears that this vessel is proceeding to your port to receive her engines and boilers, and that to complete the survey for classification the engine and boiler casing tops require to be riveted and completed; the steering gear to be supplied and fitted and connection of gear to be completed; the steam windlass to be fitted and connections to be examined, and the pumping arrangements require to be carried out in accordance with the approved plan.

I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to your satisfaction, forward a report on the same on Report 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.


