The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

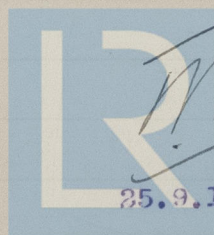

Signature of Surveyor FIRST ENTRY.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Hull Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is proceeding to their port to receive her engines and boilers, and to complete the survey for classification the engine and boiler casing tops require to be riveted and completed, steering engine to be supplied and fitted and connection of gear to be completed, steam windlass to be fitted and connections to be examined. The pumping arrangements require to be carried out in accordance with the approved plan.

The Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention and on completion of the work to their satisfaction, report upon the same with a view to the classification of the vessel.
