In reply to your letter of the 15th instant regarding survey held at this Port on the above vessel, we have to inform you that the Engineer Superintendent, who was onboard vessel at this Port, requested the safety valves of the bone and blubber boilers be adjusted to 60 lbs. per square inch, as this was the highest pressure they wished to use.

The small items referred to in our Report No. 18854, consist of name plates, pipe clips and a few extension spindles to couple up.


