Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 5th instant, respecting the case of the s.s. "JELICOE ROSE" (Glasgow first entry report No.40105), and have to inform you that in view of the fact that the engines and boilers were surveyed under specification until 75% completed, an account has to-day been rendered to the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the proportion of the fees due for the survey during construction of this machinery up to the time of transfer to private ownership, which in this case will amount to say £4:0:0.

On payment of this fee your account will be credited accordingly, and I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
