We communicated with the British Vice Consul in Cartagena, respecting this vessel and we are now informed by this gentleman that the steamer "GLORIA" has been sold to P.F. Bruce, and the style of his firm appears to be Messrs Hudson & Bruce, 33 Dock Street, Dundee.

The Gloria sailed from Cartagena on the 7th insts. for Dundee.
