We are in receipt of your Classing Letters dated 18th March and 20th April and in reply beg to state the following:-

- (1) The stern tubes are fitted with "CUTLESS" rubber bushes.
- (2) The vessel is now in service between Szczecin and Gdansk, but arrangements have been made to complete the Electrical Report 13 at the earliest opportunity.
- (3) The Owners Representative states that they do not require the torsional vibration characteristics.

It is noted that the Rule Equipment letter is "j" not "i". The Owners Representative states that a bower anchor of not less than 18 cwts., and 30 fathoms of 1. 3/16" diameter chain cable have been ordered and will be fitted on board when delivered.
