
The dry cargo hold (with ceiling lifted) and the pump room have been examined and cofferdams tested and found satisfactory. ✓

Very few plans were available, the scantlings being checked against plans supplied by London Office of a sister vessel ("EL KARIM").

The First Entry Report on the machinery was in hand before leaving Gdynia.
