Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that Reports 8 and 9 have now been received from Gdynia, signed by Mr. Ellison, and on your behalf on the twin screw Motorship "TURNIA".

3. No reference, however, is made in this report to the scantlings and arrangements of the vessel, and before submitting the case to the Committee for final classification, I shall be obliged if you will state whether the scantlings have been verified and found to agree with the approved plans, and whether a First Entry Report in accordance with the Circular No. 1871 is being furnished.

At the same time it is desired to know whether the dry cargo hold (with ceiling lifted) and the pump room have been examined and whether the cofferdams have been tested and found satisfactory.

I may add that no plans or First Entry Report on the machinery have yet been submitted and I shall also be glad to receive your remarks in this connection.
