Received 17/11/28.

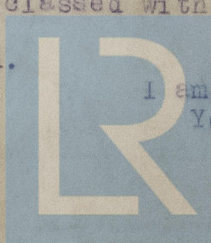
"KOSOKU MARU Please refer to your letter of 2nd May, Cable how case stands."
