This tug is of the H.S. type built by Messrs Phillip & Sons, Dartmouth, for the Admiralty in 1917.

With a view to classification with this Society plans and particulars were examined in this Office and the Owners' representative informed that provided the usual conditions be complied with and a favourable report be received from the Surveyors the vessel could be recommended for the class A- "For towing services".

The London Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, and the requirements of a 1st S.S.No.3 complied with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed A- "For towing services", with record of survey 3,27 and notation of S.S.Lon. No.3-3,27.
