I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the dredger "MADRAS" and to say that your remarks have been noted.

As regards the question of freeboard I may say that freeboard certificates were issued to this vessel by the Board of Trade on the 20th January 1904, and these certificates remain in force so long as the vessel retains her original class in the Society's Register Book. If, however the Owners now wish to have freeboards assigned by this Society it will be necessary for you to forward full particulars on Report Form 11b together with the usual Freeboard Request Form duly signed by a Representative of the Owners.
