
Dear Sir,

F. I have to acquaint you that a letter was recently received from the Danish Government intimating that International Convention freeboards had been assigned by them to the Motorship "SELANDIA" and that the necessary certificates had been issued in accordance therewith.

I am informed by the Copenhagen Surveyors that this ship is now on her way to America, and it is understood she will trade between San Francisco and Shanghai during the next two years, and as freeboard is a condition of this vessel's class, I shall be glad if you will be so good as to arrange for the San Francisco Surveyors to forward to this Office a verification of marking form in this case, together with full particulars of any alterations which have been carried out to satisfy the Danish Authorities in compliance with the Convention requirements.
