Dear Sirs,

Replying to your letter of 9th April respecting the "STANVAC WELLINGTON", I have to say that in the case of Panamanian ships, the Load Line Certificate can be issued either from the New York Office or from here and the records of such ships are, therefore, kept in duplicate.

In future cases, therefore, I shall be glad if you will arrange for your report on the Freeboard Survey to be prepared in duplicate, one copy being sent to the New York Office and the other to the London Office.

As regards the report 8, however, this document requires to be placed before the Committee and should, therefore, be sent to the London Office and not the New York Office.

In these circumstances, I shall be obliged if you will arrange for a copy of your Form C.12a and C.11 (d) to be forwarded to this Office and the New York Office is being requested to forward your report 8 here for consideration.
