With reference to the First Entry Reports on the Motor Tank Barge "SEVERN CARRIER" (Messrs. Charles Hill & Sons' Yard No.205) I have to say that full particulars of the air receivers should have been given on these reports.

Plans for a riveted air receiver and for a solid drawn receiver were submitted by the Engine Makers for this vessel, and it is concluded that the receivers were constructed under special survey in the usual way.

In the event of your not having taken a note of the test marks on the receivers, and your not having any information regarding them, you should communicate with the Society's Surveyors at Southampton regarding the matter.
