have one shaft bracket manufactured by them for the order of Messrs  
Mitsubishi Nagasaki Zosensho and on inspection found to be, as far as  
could be ascertained, sound and free from defects.

The shaft bracket is casted from S.M. steel and annealed.

Test pieces for tension and bending each were taken from both ends.

Tensile strength and elongation were found to be as follows:-
