Motorship "HODA" ex "JARMONA"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

To enable a certificate to be issued by the Society for the ship to proceed from Norway to Piraeus for Special Survey it will be necessary for an examination to be carried out in drydock and the vessel found or placed in satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage.

So far as the machinery is concerned, all main and auxiliary machinery, including pumping arrangements, would require to be tried under working conditions, the electrical equipment megger tested and generally examined. In addition, if steam is required during the voyage, then a Donkey Boiler Survey should be held.

Any certificate issued by the Society will indicate that the ship is unclassified during the voyage.

I take this opportunity to point out that no part of the Special Survey has been held.

I am sending a copy of this letter to the Society's Surveyors at Oslo and, no doubt, the new Owners will request attendance of a Surveyor from that office when the ship is ready for survey.
