Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to your letters of the 23rd February and 3rd July last, respecting the motorship "ARDOR", I have to acquaint you that a report has recently come to hand from the Naples Surveyor from which it appears that the vessel has been examined in drydock. Nothing however has been done to bring the Continuous Survey of the Oil Engines up to date, and the only parts of the machinery examined since January last are two crossheads. If however it is the Owners' intention to open up the whole of the machinery when the Special Survey No.3 is completed in February next, the Continuous Survey need not be proceeded with in the interim, but I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know the Owners' proposal in this connection.
