We have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, in which you advise that the shell connections of the side transverses as fitted in the above vessel are formed of angles 150 x 90 x 12 m/m and 90 x 90 x 11 m/m, instead of angles 150 x 150 x 11.5 m/m and 90 x 90 x 11 m/m, as approved.
