No.1 Keel plate forward indented.

To be removed, faired & refitted.

No.1 plate in A strake on port & starboard side (2 plates) indented.

To be removed, faired & refitted.

No.2 plate on port side slightly indented.

To be faired in place & 2 floors in way of these indented plates to be repaired if found necessary. No.1 double bottom tank to be tested after completion of repairs & proven sound and tight.

Studs in stern tube guard ring broken.

To be renewed.
