This vessel was built in 1919 by Messrs. McDougall Duluth Co., to class with the American Bureau, and appears to have been constructed to plans which were mutually approved by this Society and the American Bureau, to which plans a very large number of vessels were built during the War.

It is now desired by the Owners, the Hammond Lumber Co., to class the ship with this Society, and a First Entry Report has been received from the Newport News Surveyors, together with plans of the vessel as built.

The scantlings and arrangements as shown on the plans have been compared with the requirements of the Rules for the class 100A1 and are found to be in order.
