Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 25th ultimo, respecting your steamer "UNO", and note that you have decided to withdraw this vessel from the Society's Classification as she is to be commissioned for coasting service only.

It is understood from the Society's Surveyor at Rio de Janeiro that the same remarks apply in the case of your steamer "UNA", and in the circumstances the Committee, who have had the matter before them to-day, have decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the classes of these vessels, the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
