Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo with its enclosures respecting the Steamer "SENAI", the contents of which are noted.

With regard thereto I have to say that the originally approved equipment on board for this 'shelt' type vessel built to the BS* (with Freeboard) class was as follows:-

2 bowers at ^{11 1/4} 4 ₂ cwt stockless
1 stream " 4 ₂ " ex stock
165 fathoms of 1.2/16" stud chain cable.

The equipment tonnage in the Register Book is 528 in association with the notation C 18 which indicates that the diameter of cable on board is $\frac{16}{16}$ 18/16" but that the equipment in this instance was specially approved. The Owners should therefore be informed that the equipment of anchors and chain cables on board this ship-and sister ships should be as ^{that} originally approved, particulars of which are given above.
