This is a 'Shelt' type vessel built by Henry Scarr, Ltd., Hessle to class BS\* (with Freeboard).

The original approved equipment on board consisted of:-

- { 2 bowers at  $4\frac{11}{4}$  cwt stockless
- { 1 stream "  $4\frac{3}{2}$  " ex stock
- { 165 fathoms of 1.2/16" stud chain cable.

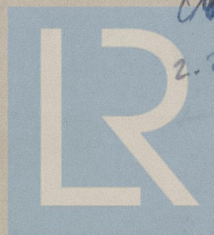
The equipment tonnage in the Register Book is 528 in association with the notation C  $\frac{18}{16}$  which indicates that the diameter of cable on board is 18/16" but that the equipment was specially approved, and full details can only be obtained by referring the 1st entry report.
