Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Trawlers "GRAFFON" and "ELLOE", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Leith have forwarded to this Office a letter, dated 11th instant, received by them from your Granton Manager, intimating that it is not your intention to maintain the classes of these vessels in the Society's Register Book.

As you are aware, the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Special Survey No. 2 of the "GRAFFON" expired in February last and of the "ELLOE" in March last, and in February the Committee agreed to the completion of both surveys being postponed, subject to their being completed as soon as possible, and in any case not later than the end of the present month.

As it would appear, however, that it is not your intention to carry out this arrangement, the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the class of each vessel to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
