I have to acquaint you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam that the S.S. No. 82 recently built by Messrs. Van Vliet & Co., of Hardinxveld, is to be towed (via Dundee) to your port, where the machinery is to be fitted on board.

To complete the survey on the hull the engine and boiler casing tops, top of tunnel, with frames and the pillars on the tunnel require to be completed and the tunnel in way tested, and I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention and on completion forward a report on the usual form for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
