It is submitted that, before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the Middlebro' Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is to be towed from Rotterdam to their port, via Dundee, for the purpose of having the machinery placed on board and that to complete the Survey on the hull the engine and boiler casing tops, top of tunnel with frames & the pillars on the tunnel require to be completed & tunnel in way tested.

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention & on completion to forward a report on the usual form in order that the classification may be completed.
