S I beg to acquaint you that your letter of even date regarding the steamer "HELGA MOLLER" was read to the Committee at their meeting today.

In view of the definite opinion expressed by the Shanghai Surveyor that he was unable to recommend class continuance until repairs had been completed to his satisfaction, the Committee could not see their way to agree to your suggestion and accordingly had no option but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a black line indicating reported defects.

I may add that cabled advice to this effect has been sent to the Shanghai Surveyor asking him to inform your Shanghai House accordingly.
