For your information when I sent the telegram to you the Owners' **superintendent** stated the vessel would be prepared for our examination on her return to this port.

I addressed a letter to this firm requesting that the vessel be prepared for the required general examination with repairs and pointed out to them that the vessel's class had been continued as from August for a period of 6 months only and requiring this examination with repairs by February 1947.
