Dear Sir,

With reference to your reports Nos. 4813 and 4800 on the steamer "HELGA MOLLER", I shall be glad to learn how this case stands as regards the carrying out of the General Examination for maintenance of class and necessary repairs, as required, by the end of the present month.

It is concluded a survey for the renewal of the Load Line Certificate will be carried out concurrently with the General Examination.

I shall also be glad if you will ascertain from the Chang Kee Steamship Co. Ltd., the present Owners of the steamer "HENG CHUN" ex "HETTON", and let me know what arrangements have been made in regard to the carrying out of the General Examination for maintenance of class and the Load Line Renewal Survey, which require to be held by the end of the present month, also the Boiler Survey which became due at the end of October last.

I may say that the vessel was under survey at Alexandria during December last for repairs but the report of this inspection has not yet been received.

I may add that the vessel was examined at Newcastle-on-Tyne in November last with a view to the General Examination being postponed until the end of this month this arrangement being approved subject to all outstanding surveys being carried out on arrival at a Far Eastern port.
