Dear Sirs,

Reverting to my letter of the 23rd ultimo respecting the fees to be charged for the survey for Classification of the Steamer "KURMARK" (your reports Nos. 12292 and 12319) I have now to inform you that it has been decided to charge a fee of £200 to include the Classification, Special Survey No.3, Damage Survey and expenses on the hull and machinery as follows:-

Hull.....	£150
Machinery.....	50

Of the hull fee, which will also include the Late Fee of £rs.60, referred to in your letter of the 20th ultimo, for services rendered by Mr Croudace, your account will be credited with £140, and for the machinery the total fee of £50, making in all £190.

An additional account for the fee due for the survey and assignment of freeboard, amounting to £11, has also been rendered, and of this amount your account will be credited with £8. This will leave a balance of £10 for the survey of the hull and £3 of the freeboard fee to be credited to the London account for the survey held at this port.

I may add that payment of the above fees has to-day been received and your account has accordingly been credited with the amount due to your port as mentioned above, viz:-£198 in all, which you will be good enough to note and see that the necessary entries are passed through your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
