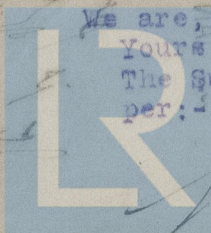
We propose to charge a special additional fee of Frs.60 for services rendered in this case, and we shall be glad to know if this amount may be credited to the Surveyor when paid.
