Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 20th ultimo respecting the Steamer "ISA VIGO" ex "TAARNHOLM", which received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, together with your report No.13480.

A fresh docking date of 6,51 was accordingly assigned and the recommendation as shown on your interim certificate that the class should be continued until the end of September was confirmed.

In view of the general condition of the ship as reported by you in October last, however, the Committee were unable to agree to any further postponement of the Special Survey beyond the end of September next, being indisposed to enter into any compromise arrangement embodying a limitation of service as suggested.

The Society's Surveyors at Genoa are therefore being informed and instructed to convey the Committee's decision both to the new Owners and to the Registro Italiano.
