Further to your letter of the 25th. May 1961, and our telephone conversation of the 2nd. inst., with reference to the above vessels general examination or commencement of Special Survey at Liverpool, I have to inform you it is now the Owners intention to carry out either general examination complete, or commence Special Survey when they drydock the ship at Liverpool, where she is proceeding from this port via Flushing. (See attached copy of Agents letter dated 2nd. June 1961).

A Greek load line certificate has been issued here, after a satisfactory general examination of the freeboard items, the freeboards verified, and the lettering on the ships sides amended to Greek characters.

The re-registration was sighted on board and the Official Number and Signal Letters were inserted on the new load line certificates before being issued.

A complete survey of the Safety Equipment has also been carried out for which Report S.E.1 is being forwarded to London with the recommendation that a Safety Equipment Certificate be issued. A Report 10 has been placed on board the vessel.

A letter has also been forwarded to the Surveyors Liverpool, copy of which is attached, along with a copy of your letter of the 25th. May 1961.
