A Greek Load Line Certificate has been issued here, after carrying out a satisfactory general examination of the freeboard items and verifying the freeboards and lettering on the ship's sides. The re-registration of the ship was sighted on board and the official number and signal letters were inserted on Load Line Certificates.

A completion survey of the Safety Equipment has been held and Report S.E.1, is being sent to the London Office of the Society with the recommendation that a Safety Equipment Certificate is issued.

It was originally intended to carry out a general examination at Middlesbrough when the vessel changed ownership, however the Owners stated that they desired if possible to commence special survey when the vessel drydocked at Liverpool, where she was proceeding from this port via Flushing.

Permission was granted from London Office by telephone for the vessel to proceed to Liverpool, on the understanding that she would be drydocking there, and that either the General Examination would be carried out completely, or the Special Survey would be commenced.
