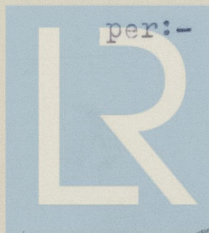
## "WAYNEGATE"

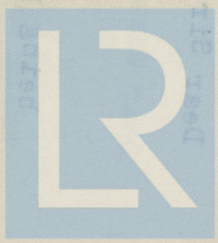
