S. Reverting to my letter of the 9th February in reply to yours of the 24th January respecting the fee of £4.4.0 charged by the Society's Surveyor at Milford for the survey of repairs of damage to your steam trawler "MADDEN" in September last, I have to point out that the fee in question appears to remain unpaid, and in the circumstances no record of the vessel's surveys can be made in the Register Book until all the fees have been paid.
