Dear Sir,

S. With reference to your two letters, one dated February 1926 and the other the 22nd February 1926, respecting the steam trawlers "PESQUERIAS CANTABRICAS NO.1" and "PESQUERIAS CANTABRICAS NO.3", I think it well to point out that in the case of the "PESQUERIAS CANTABRICAS NO.1" the Second Special Survey No.1 has been held except as regards the examination of the bunkers, and fees amounting to 550 pesetas and 350 pesetas have been charged for the survey of the hull and machinery respectively, in addition to expenses.

In the case of the "PESQUERIAS CANTABRICAS NO.2" the Special Survey No.1 has been held except the examination of the bunkers, and the fees charged were 650 pesetas and 350 pesetas on hull and machinery respectively, in addition to expenses.

For the reclassification of the "PESQUERIAS CANTABRICAS NO.3", it will be necessary to carry out the requirements of a Second Special Survey No.1, and the fees to be charged would be governed by the nature and extent of
