With reference to your letter of the 11th instant enclosing one dated 28th June from the Admiralty Overseer at Brightlingsea regarding the survey of Admiralty Steam Trawlers laid up at that Base; I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Admiralty, a copy of which I enclose, regarding the Periodical Surveys becoming due on 40 trawlers which are at present laid up at various ports.
