With reference to your letter of the 4th instant regarding the case of the steamer "SLAVIJA" I have to inform you that there are no double bottom tanks fitted in this vessel. The plating in way of the sidelights has been examined and found satisfactory. No watertight doors are fitted in this vessel. The sounding pipes have been examined. The requirements of Section 48 of the Rules have been complied with, excepting the examination of the vessel in dry dock and the drilling of shell plating.

No test certificates of materials could be obtained.

The necessary particulars on first entry report forms are being prepared and will be forwarded to you in a few days. On taking up duties at Fiume Mr. Geniram was given full notes on the case.
