2 PLANS

Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 25th ultimo respecting the S.S. "SLAVIJA" I have to inform you that the scantlings and arrangements indicated on the plans have been examined, and that provided the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules for vessels not built under survey be complied with, and a satisfactory report be received from you on the completion of the survey, the vessel will be eligible for the class A- "For service in the Adriatic", subject to the freeboards to be assigned by the Committee, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificates of classification, and recorded in the Register Book.

If the figure "1" is desired, particulars of the equipment at present on board the vessel should be forwarded for consideration.

You should also forward full particulars, on form 11b, for freeboard assignment, and in view of the class desired you should state the draft required for service. You should further state the position of sidelights or other openings through the vessel's sides. The approved plans, which are returned herewith, should be forwarded with the freeboard report for reference.
