Steel Screw Steamer "SLAVIJA", No. 31205 in R.B. Built by Messrs. M. U. Martinolich in 1911 and classed A with the Austrian Veritas.

Rule Dimensions: 123.82 x 20.66 x 10.25
Scantling Numbers: 30.91 & 3827
Proportions: Length = 12 Depths to Length.

A letter has been received from the Fiume Surveyor enclosing plans of midship section and outline profile and stating that it is now desired that the vessel should be classed with this Society.

The scantlings and arrangements as indicated on the plans have been examined, and it is submitted that they are such as merit approval for the class A- "For service in the Adriatic", *subject to the freeboards &c.*

The requirements of Section 48 of the Rules for vessels not built under survey should be complied with.

If the figure 1 is desired, particulars of the equipment at present on board the vessel should be forwarded for consideration.

The Surveyor should forward full particulars on form 11b for freeboard assignment, and in view of the class desired should state the draught required for service. They should also state the position of sidelights or other openings through the vessel's sides. The approved plans should be forwarded with the freeboard report for reference.
