

# New Doomba

Proposed conversion of the ex-Admiralty Minesweeper "WEXFORD"  
into a passenger steamer for service in Brisbane Harbour.

Dimensions: 220 x 28.5 x 16.25 moulded

Plans of midship section and general arrangement  
submitted in duplicate by the Glasgow Office, together with a  
letter from the Coaster Construction Company stating that the  
vessel when converted is intended for service in Brisbane  
Harbour or Bay.

This vessel was built by Messrs. W. Simons & Co.  
in 1918/19, and is one of a number of the same class built to  
the order of the Admiralty under the survey of this Society,  
some of which have since been converted into combined passenger  
and cargo boats for coastal service.

It is submitted that provided the alterations be  
carried out in accordance with the plan submitted, and the  
structural arrangements be to the Surveyors' satisfaction,  
the vessel will be worthy to be classed A- "For Service in  
"Brisbane Harbour and Bay".

The Surveyors might also be informed that a  
draft of 9 ft. could be approved, as in the case of previous  
sister vessels.
