I should like to revert to your letter of the 11th October about the Steamers "DONGARTH" and "YORKGARTH". The Rea Towing Co. have been temporising/these two cases as they have been waiting for firm dates for their new tugs to come into service.

They have now decided that they will have to keep the "DONGARTH" and "YORKGARTH" in service for another few months but it will not be worth the cost to them of putting the vessels through either Special Surveys or General Examinations for continuation of class.
