Dear Sir,

Steamers "DOUGARTH" and "YORKGARTH"

I send, for your information, a copy of a letter dated 27th September received from the Owners from which you will observe that it is improbable they will retain these ships in their service for more than a short period after the delivery of new tonnage about the end of this year.

It is fully appreciated that they are anxious not to have to submit the vessels to Special Survey, but, bearing in mind their ages, the Committee will not agree to any further postponement of the inspections without satisfactory General Examinations being held at an early date.

I shall, therefore, be glad if you will arrange with the Owners for such General Examinations to be carried out without delay and the period of deferment will be dependent upon the condition of each ship as found at the survey, but in any case not beyond the expiration of the year of grace.

You will observe that they are arranging for the Boiler Surveys to be held, but their intentions regarding the Screwshaft Survey of the "YORKGARTH", which became due at the end of June last, are awaited.
