The Wellington, N.Z. Surveyor forwards a letter received by him from the Engineer to the Owners in which he states that this vessel is to be laid up, but that he is unable to say for how long a period.

He asks, in the circumstances, how the vessel will stand as regards her classification during the time she is laid up.

The Wellington Surveyor has replied to the Engineer as follows:-

"I have to state that the Annual Surveys of the Hull and Boilers are now overdue and I note you propose carrying these out during the period the vessel is out of commission. The opening-up of the engines, tanks and interior portions

"of hull, will not be required by Lloyd's Rules till the next
"Special Survey becomes due, namely, March 1933, but the
"underwater portions of the hull are to be surveyed annually
"when practicable, so the underwater portions can be postponed
"till next year when the vessel comes here for slipping".

"If the Annual Boiler Survey is carried out, as
"requested by you, and the Boilers not put in use for some
"months afterwards, the Committee may possibly sanction an
"extension of time on the regular due date (March) for the
"next Boiler Survey period, and I am agreeable to recommend
"it to do so should your Board request this concession".
