Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a communication from this Society's Surveyors at Marseilles, forwarding one, dated the 28th ultimo, received from your goodselves, to the effect that you no longer desire the retention of the classification of your s.s. "MECANICIEN" in this Society's Register Book.

As you are no doubt aware, the Second Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in September, 1934, and her class has hitherto been allowed to remain undisturbed in the Register Book, whilst laid up, on the understanding that outstanding surveys would be completed before she was again commissioned.

The case has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, and I am directed to inform you that, in the circumstances, and having regard to the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey expired at the end of September last, they regret they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register
