

S.S. "WAR BEE"

The butts on sheerstrake and raised quarter deck are triple and quadruple riveted for one-half length. Bottom inside tanks is cement coated. The breadth and thickness of web frames are as shown on approved plans also semi box beams to collision and after peak bulkheads. There is one two-handed pump in engine room which is connected to the main bilge suction which communicates with forward and after holds. There is also one hand pump to after peak.


