SPECIFICATION FOR
REPAIRS (AND RENEWALS)
TO
TUG "ST. FAITH".

1. SPECIFICATION for work to be effected on the above named vessel now lying at Burrard Dry Dock Co.Ltd., North Vancouver.

2. It is to be understood by the Contractor that the repairs herein specified are to be carried out and completed in all the details connected therewith and that the workmanship and material must be of the best quality throughout and the materials, etc., must conform in size, etc. to those originally in the vessel, and the repairs must in every respect be made under the supervision and to the entire satisfaction of the Owners, (Underwriters) Classification Surveyor and Steamboat Inspector.

3. If any dispute or difference shall arise relating to or concerning the specifications or the meaning thereof, such dispute shall be left to the decision of the Surveyors, whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.

4. Should the contractor require the removal of any part of the vessel or her fittings, or her fuel, to enable him to make this repair, the same shall be done by him and all such removals subsequently replaced.

5. A lump sum tender will be required for all the work specified or implied, which must include the cost of all drydock rent, shoring, wharfage charges, charges for night and day watchmen, water, light, etc., and in fact any and all charges which are incidental to this repair.

6. All unused old material occasioned by the repairs to become the property of the contractor, except where otherwise stated.

7. The contractor is to fully protect the vessel and the Owners against any claim for injury to workmen, (also for any damage done to the vessel, her machinery or fittings) while the vessel is undergoing repairs.

8. The Owners reserve the right to reject any or all bids.
