

FAITH" of Vancouver: Examined the Bottom and Rudder in dry dock, also internally throughout, and alterations for conversion to Oil Fuel: All the requirements for Special Survey No.2, have been carried out both on Hull and Machinery.

A Report has been forwarded to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, recommending that the vessel be classed "A.1. for towing purposes" with record of Survey 8.26; "Special Survey No.2-26: Fitted for Oil Fuel 8.26: Lloyd's Machinery Certificate 8.26: Tail Shaft seen (Continuous Liner) 8.26".
